FIREFIGHTERS RESCUE WOMAN TRAPPED IN VEHICLE

(Palm Bay)—Palm Bay Fire-Rescue emergency medical technicians (EMT'S) and paramedics rescued a woman from a trapped vehicle after she crashed into a concrete construction barrier on I-95 early Tuesday morning. Just after 8:00 a.m. firefighters and paramedics responded to I-95 just south of Palm Bay Road near mile marker 175 after reports of a single vehicle crash. Upon arrival they found a woman trapped in her vehicle as the driver side door was smashed in. Rescuers used TNT tools, also known as the “Jaws of Life” to free the woman within ten minutes. She was then transported to a local hospital for treatment of minor injuries.
